

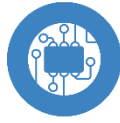

Student Travel Award

Are you an MSc or PhD student who works on a topic in Safety Engineering or Cybersecurity? Apply for the ROSAS Safety Days Student Travel Award.

The Student Travel Award is given to one or more outstanding students to cover lodging and airfare to travel to and from the conference up to an amount of CHF 400. It also includes free registration to the conference.

Eligibility requirements

Applicants must be a matriculated undergraduate or PhD student (or equivalent) at a higher education institute (University, University of Applied Sciences, Institute of Technology, etc.).

Application process

A complete application must include:

1. An abstract describing the student's research in the area of Safety Engineering or Cybersecurity (max. 2000 characters, including spaces) – Word or PDF format.
2. The candidate's CV – Word or PDF format.
3. A brief motivation – In the body of the e-mail.
4. The name of your professor or at least one other reference to confirm your candidacy.

Applications should be sent by e-mail to info@rosas.center, **before the 26th of July 2019**.

Decision of awarding

It will be notified by early August.

Requirements for accepting the award

The laureate, if he/she accepts the award, must attend the entire Safety Days conference from 18 to 19 September 2019. He/she accepts that his/her name appears at the conference and on the conference website. He/she may also be asked to present his/her work either in a poster, or in a 10-minute oral presentation. The laureate will receive details after the decision of awarding.

Conditions

Please note that the award can only be used to cover hotel costs and air, train and/or public transit fare to the conference from your home address, based on submitted evidence (invoices, tickets and boarding passes for flights). The maximum total amount the awardee can claim is 400 CHF.

The ROSAS Safety Days organization decides the awardees and will not correspond about the results.
